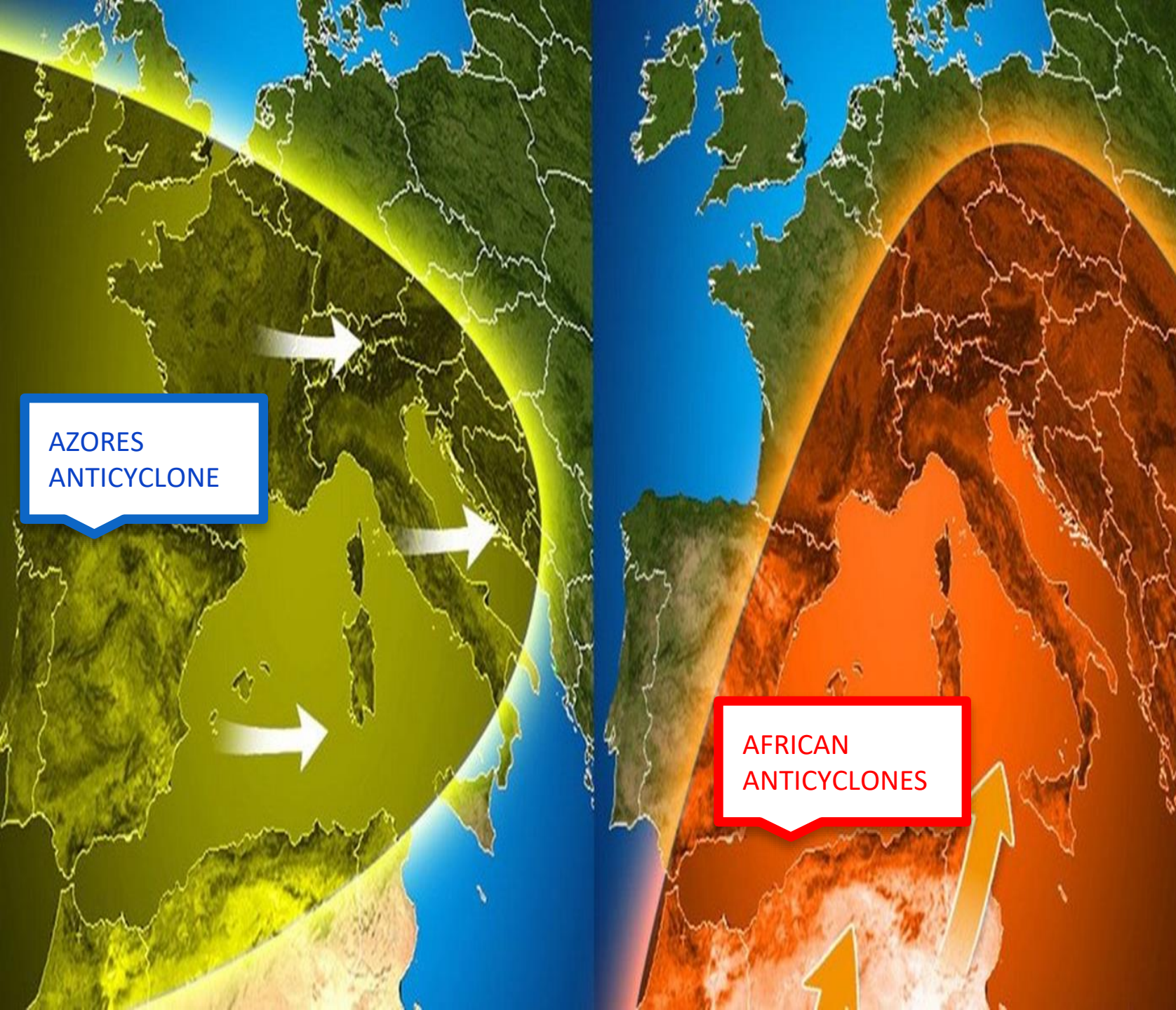

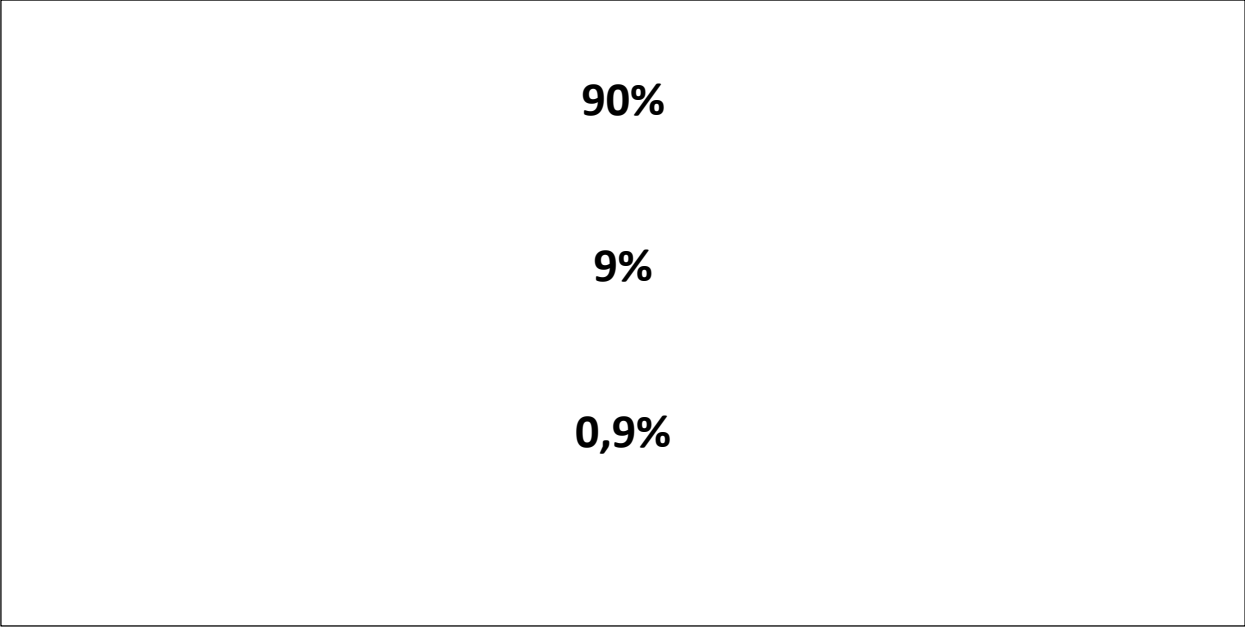

- Turning it into an opportunity of common growth and sustainable co-development



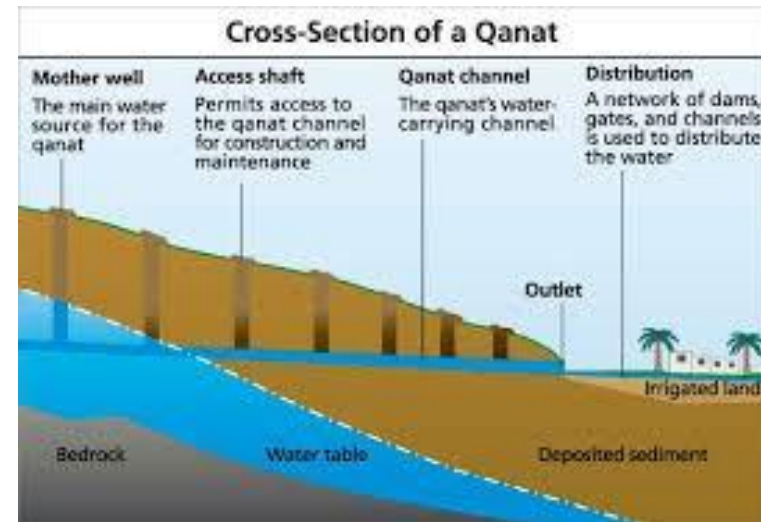
